Paddock Parking Information

Paddock will open for SPEED World Challenge participants Wednesday April 15, 2009 at 12:00 PM. All teams must stage their transporters in the South Shore Launch Ramp, 590 Queensway Drive, Long Beach. **Transporters will be led over to the paddock area in small groups by a World Challenge official. Any transporter showing up at paddock area without being led over by an official will be sent to the South Shore Launch Ramp to stage.** All SPEED World Challenge Teams must be in the paddock no later than Thursday April 16, 2009 at 11:00 AM

Team passenger cars will be limited to one automobile per race car participant and will be parked in the Arena Parking Structure. Vehicles requiring access to the Arena Parking Structure must be in the garage **by 7:00 a.m.** each race day morning. Oversize vehicles will not be allowed in the Arena Parking Structure. Parking passes will be distributed to SPEED World Challenge GT Series teams by the SPEED World Challenge Series credential office.
